OCTOBER LUNCHEON GUEST SPEAKER-DOUG PETERSEN



Doug grew up on the East Coast and shortly after he entered a military college, he enlisted in the US Army and went to flight school to learn to fly helicopters. He is a decorated Vietnam veteran, flying medical evacuation helicopters, DUSTOFF, saving hundreds of lives. He flew nearly 1,000 combat hours and was shot down twice trying to evacuate American and allied soldiers from the jungles and rice paddies of Vietnam. He continued to serve more than twenty years as an aviator in the United States Army, including two tours in Germany and multiple stateside assignments. The aircraft he flew include the UH-1 Huey, OH-59 Kiowa, UH-60 Blackhawk, U-21 and the C-12.

Doug continued to serve others by working in the financial services industry for twenty-five years, helping families with their financial security.

He is an award-winning author of six enlightening, thought-provoking books, reaffirming the good in all of us. His fourth, fifth, and sixth books were Global eBook winners under the Inspirational/Visionary Non-fiction category. Doug went into professional speaking, facilitating workshops for organizations, as well as some personal coaching on core values and discovering a person's life's purpose.

Doug and his wife, Ann, actively volunteer with Project Sanctuary, a non-profit organization helping our military/veteran families heal together through challenging times. He and his wife have accumulated more than 2,700 volunteer hours over the last 5 years. They were recognized as Project Sanctuary's 2020 Volunteers of the Year.

The Texas Department of Motor Vehicles announced that, as of January 1, 2022, anyone parking in a disabled parking space must have a license plate or a disabled parking placard that features the International Symbol of Access (ISA).

Currently, disabled Veteran license plates do not feature the ISA. If you want to continue using disabled parking spaces, beginning in 2022, you must apply for a disabled parking placard or for new disabled Veteran license plates featuring the ISA.
