Lee Ellis served in the United States Coast Guard from 1981 to 1987. He was a Boatswain's Mate, NCO.

(Fun Fact: Lee is only 1 of 5 Coast Guard members on our books!)

Lee served on ships, small boats, and shore stations during his time in the Coast Guard performing many of its missions. Those missions included search and rescue, maintaining aids to navigation, port safety, maritime law enforcement, and marine environmental protection.

The Coast Guard is a relatively small service as compared to the other branches, but its mission and history are broad and grand. Placed within the Department of Homeland Security most people don't know much about the Coast Guard even though it is America's oldest maritime defender.

Lee has been a member of Roll Call for almost 6 years and has a strong patriotic passion for America and those who have served. WWII veterans, however, have always had a special place in his heart. This started

with his grandfather, Army Master Sergeant H.L. Ellis Sr., whose long service began in 1913 just before the start of WWI and continued until his retirement in 1957. Many WWII veterans of Roll Call are Lee's "oldest best friends" with whom he enjoys spending time and helping to keep their stories alive.

Lee hopes his talk will be a reminder to all of the importance of organizations like Roll Call and will provide a better understanding of what the United States Coast Guard is all about.
