Upon graduation he went into the army and after boot camp at Ft. Leonard Wood and AIT in Ft. Ord, off to Vietnam he went. Bill was assigned to A Troop, 1/9 of the 1st Cavalry Division. The first six months in country Bill went on a number of harrowing missions which included rappelling into hot landing zones and securing perimeters around downed helicopters. A boring day could suddenly turn into green tracers flying past your head and the thump of rounds hitting the helicopter that you're in. Bill lived through many events of this nature and after the 1st Cav rotated back to the states, he was transferred to an office job further south that allowed him to in his words, "get house-broke again" before returning stateside.






Dale Robinson will celebrate his 100th Birthday on January 12th!

Vietnam Era Veteran Pinning and Welcome Home!

If you served in the Vietnam Era and have NOT received a Welcome Home pin and certificate, please let us know that you would like to receive one when you RSVP for the luncheon.

Changes to Texas laws for veterans effective in 2022

- New Veteran-owned businesses—exempt from franchise tax and waive all state filing fees
- 100% disabled veterans qualify for a total homestead property tax exemption, regardless of whether they are actually receiving that compensation
- Expands the eligibility of surviving spouses of veterans' who died in accidents such as car crashes and other noncombat events for a total property tax exemption (formerly only those who died in the line of duty qualified)
- Big change! Disabled veterans with the DV license plates will need to apply for a new license plate or
 placard with the international symbol of access in order to park in disabled parking. Eligibility rules can
 be found at txdmv.gov
