Jack Stowe was born in Denton, Tx and around 1934 the family moved to Ft. Worth. When Pearl Harbor was bombed Jack was 15 years old and was known for getting into trouble. About four months later it looked like Jack was going to end up in the reformatory because of his behavior so, with the help of a secretary doing some paperwork magic, Jack suddenly was old enough to join the Navy. After boot camp and an attempt at radio school, Jack ended up in a seaplane observation unit and shipped out to the Solomon Islands.

The Japanese pulled the last of their troops off of Guadalcanal in February, 1943, the same month Jack arrived on Florida Island, 20 miles across Iron Bottom Bay from Guadalcanal. Japanese bombers prowled the skies while US Navy patrol torpedo boats prowled the waters around the Solomon Islands.

Jack would watch Henderson Field get bombed and then see the PT boats head out in the evening on their way to patrol. Who knows how many times he witnessed Lt. Kennedy go by in PT 109. After almost two years in the South Pacific, Jack returned to the states and was discharged in January, 1946. Jack's brother also served in the Pacific after also joining at the age of 15. Last December the two of them went to Pearl Harbor together for the 80th anniversary of the attack.
















Biography
