# LUNCHEON SPEAKER—John Yuill



Born in 1934 in Boswell, Indiana, John Yuill's journey is nothing short of remarkable. He began his service in the U.S. Air Force in 1954, starting as a navigator and later becoming a pilot. His courage and dedication shone brightest during the Vietnam War, where he served as a B-52 Aircraft Commander.

On December 22, 1972, during Operation Linebacker II, his aircraft was struck over Hanoi, Vietnam, forcing him to make a

harrowing decision. Despite the intense danger, he chose to bail out, leading to his capture as a Prisoner of War in the notorious "Hanoi Hilton." Lt. Col. Yuill's story of survival and resilience is nothing short of awe-inspiring.

He was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for his heroism during this mission, demonstrating exceptional courage and selfless dedication to duty.
