LUNCHEON SPEAKER—Bob Whiteside



Bob Whiteside grew up in Chicago and joined the army in 1963. After spending time in Greece and Korea, Bob went to Vietnam in October, 1966. Bob was assigned to the 15th Engineers with the 9th Infantry Division. His outfit was moved further south and started operating in the Mekong Delta early on from Bearcat Base. The area was mainly controlled by Viet Cong. At one point, a tunnel was discovered under the base which led to the discovery of three more tunnels. Just by chance, a major attack had been averted. Bob had numerous other adventures running supplies up roads where one never knew where the enemy was lying in wait. Bob returned to the states in April of 1968 and discharged in 1970
